

Christmas...

I wonder what you think of Christmas? It saddens me to realise that if most people were asked this question, they would not dream of mentioning the Lord Jesus in their reply. This would certainly have been true of me until I was about twenty years old.

But there are others who certainly would say that the coming of God's Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, into this world as a baby, is why Christmas is really special to them. They truly believe in Him.

It is of vital importance for every one of us to **know** that Jesus **IS** precious to **me**. The Bible's clear teaching is wonderfully summarised in this way: For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. This is why every true believer in Jesus can say from their heart that His coming into the world means everything to them.

God teaches us that death is not the end of our existence. It is appointed unto man once to die - but after death the judgment. There will be a judgment but genuine believers should never fear death because they will not perish but have everlasting life - Jesus has paid the penalty for all their sins so they will not perish. No wonder Jesus is so precious to everyone who believes in Him! No wonder we celebrate Christmas! And no wonder we long and pray that the Lord Jesus will soon be precious to many others too!
