This message reminded me of the challenging words of the Lord Jesus recorded in the Bible:

Behold, I stand at the door and knock.

If anyone hears My voice and opens the door,

I recall my own experience of hearing that 'knock' when I was about 20 years old. I had always regarded myself as a Christian but so many 'knocks' demanded my time and energy that I foolishly (and sinfully!) ignored the greatest of all God's commandments - You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.'

I realised that God was 'knocking' - urging me to hand over the control of my life to Him. I struggled as I considered the change this would make - but I have never - even for one moment - regretted responding to that knock!

I know that if I had continued to live for myself and not for Him - the future would be bleak indeed - for one day we will all give an account of our lives to God. The Lord Jesus died to save us from the terrible and eternal consequences of our sins and now He says Come to Me and I will give you rest. 
