What is a Christian? The Bible says that the disciples of Jesus were called Christians first at Antioch. It also reveals the truths that revolutionised lives making people genuine disciples of the Lord Jesus Christ.

The apostle Paul summarizes the Christian message in this way: I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, by which also you are saved, that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day...

This is the foundation of the Christian faith - what every disciple of the Lord Jesus believes. A Christian is a saved person! God makes it crystal clear that we are all sinners - condemned before Him. But He has a made a way for us to be saved - forgiven. This is why every Christian is so thankful that the Lord Jesus died for our sins as He suffered on the cross. We especially think of this on Good Friday. Then - showing the sacrifice was accepted by His Father - He was raised to life. This we joyfully celebrate especially on Easter Sunday.

I wonder if you are a Christian – someone whose life has been transformed by the Christian message; a person truly thankful to God for saving us through the death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ.
